Product name	Philips Flat screen televisions with screen sizes 20” and 26”

Product description	Philips has identified a potential safety issue with a batch of flat screen televisions with screen sizes 20” and 26”. These televisions were manufactured earlier this year and are now in shops. The company says that within a batch of televisions manufactured between March 2008 and August 2008, there could be a faulty component part. In specific models of the televisions, screws might become loose inside the set, which can lead to the power unit shifting, and over time create a potential shock hazard that may lead to injury. There have been no reported accidents but Philips will be recalling these models as a precautionary measure.
